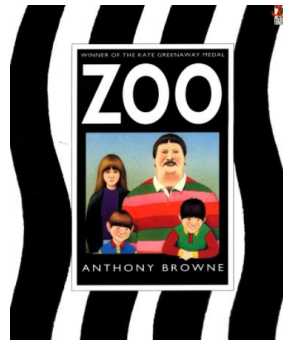

Reading

This half term we would like your child to read at least four times per week as we start the academic year. We ask that the children are listened to reading by an adult or older sibling and that this is recorded in their school reading record.

This half-term we would like to encourage the children to read a book by Anthony Brown called 'Zoo' and look at the main theme of a character in the story.



The children made a fantastic effort with their home reading last year and we hope that they maintain this hard work for the beginning of the new academic year. We will be regularly speaking to the children about the books that they are reading and celebrating their reading achievements in class.

The children will be learning the following common exception words (tricky words) over the course of the year. Due to the children missing Year 2 in Spring and the Summer term onwards we are going to focus on the Year 2 CEW words first. Please support your child in learning these key spellings.

Home Learning creative Project

This term in Year 3, the children will be learning in Science: animals and skeletons. To support this learning we would like all children to complete some research on an animal of their choice and create a fact file. We want the children to be creative and use pictures, headings, facts and anything else that would interest the reader.

Hot Topic to discuss!

Our DT this half term is about the food groups, nutrition and healthy eating, the children certainly enjoyed our fruit smoothies!

As an extra home learning challenge – can you investigate a variety of different foods and discuss how many grams of sugar are contained in the product? Decide which product is the healthiest and why. Discuss what could be eaten as an alternative to foods with high quantities of fats and/or sugar. It may be that your child wishes to present their findings in a creative way. Let your imagination run free and we look forward to hearing about your discussions and views in school over the next half term.
